### How to Get a Tax ID Number

### Why does my club need a tax id number?

Three reasons: (1) to set up a bank account, (2) to receive ASUA funds, and (3) other financial reasons.

# How do I know if my club has a tax id number?

If your club has a bank account, then it has a tax id number. A tax id number is required to set up a business bank account. If you have misplaced the tax id number, the bank should be able to provide it upon request.

## How do I get a tax id number for my club?

To obtain a tax id number, also called an employee identification number (EIN), visit https://sa.www4.irs.gov/modiein/individual/index.jsp and click begin application.

## How do I navigate the online application using "EIN Assistant"?

The bullets below represent an answer for each part of the application:

- 1. "View Additional Types"
- 2. "Other"
- 3. "Continue"
- 4. "Banking Purposes"
- 5. "Individual"
- 6. Here you will be asked to put in a social security number and click "I am a responsible officer...".
  - a. NOTE: Please make sure someone who is comfortable entering his/her number provides this. The website is through the U,S. IRS so it is a secured site.
- 7. Please put in a permanent address for your club,
  - a. NOTE: Check with your landlord you can use this address for your club. Nothing should be sent to this address unless your club wants to apply to be a 501(c)(3) non-profit. For more information on this, see below
- 8. You must provide the FULL name of your organization, with no abbreviations. The

- organizations start date is your club's date of adoption or when your club formed.
- 9. The answers to all of the questions on the next portion should be "No" but be sure to double check this is true for your club.
- 10. "Other"
- 11. "Other" and in the space write "University Club"
- 12. I would suggest receiving the letter online. This way you are will receive your confirmation document in electronic form, which is easier to send and store.
- 13. "Submit"
- 14. Write down your tax id number and save the PDF letter. Click on the link to see the letter and be sure to hold on to this document!
- 15. You now have a tax id number.

### Should my club apply for 501(c)(3) status?

Although your club may be eligible for 501(c)(3) non-profit status, the fees to file the application are approximately \$400, which may outweigh the benefits. These benefits include eligibility to receive tax deductible charitable contributions and exemption from federal income tax. To apply for 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, your club must file IRS Form 1023. Completing this form is known to require knowledge of legal and tax technicalities, for which you will need a lawyer and an accountant.
