## APPLICATION FOR THE POSITION OF STUDENT REGENT, 2019-2021 TERM

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

#### Arizona Board of Regents

In 1864, the first Territorial Legislature authorized the establishment of the University of Arizona and provided for the management, direction, governance, and control by a Board of Regents. The state colleges, one in Tempe and one in Flagstaff, were governed by a three-member State Board of Education that included the Superintendent of Public Instruction and two members appointed by the Governor. In March of 1945, the Governor signed House Bill 136 uniting the governing boards of the university and state colleges of Arizona. The authority of the Board of Regents expanded to include the Arizona State Teachers College at Tempe (since 1958 Arizona State University), and Arizona State Teachers College at Flagstaff (since 1966 Northern Arizona University). The Arizona Board of Regents is the governing board for the state's public universities: Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University, and the University of Arizona. The Board provides policy guidance in such areas as: academic and student affairs; financial and human resource programs; student tuition, fees, and financial aid programs; university capital development plans; strategic plans; legal affairs; and public and constituent outreach. The Board consists of twelve members, eleven voting and one non-voting. This includes the Governor and Superintendent of Public Instruction as ex-officio members, each serving while they hold office, and two Student Regents. Also at the table, and an essential partner with the Board of Regents is the chair of the Arizona Faculties Council - the coordinating body for the faculty governments of the three universities. Except for ex-officio members and Student Regents, and as noted, the term of a Regent is eight years. As Regents finish their terms, new Regents are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate.

#### Student Regent

A student was first added to the Board in a non-voting position in 1978. The Student Regent was granted voting privileges during the 1989-90 term. A statute passed by the 44<sup>th</sup> Legislature in 2000 added a second, non-voting student voting member to the Arizona Board of Regents. Student Regents are now appointed for two year terms. Student Regents represent all students from the state's three public universities (ASU, NAU, and UA). Student Regents will hold the full rights granted to all members of the Arizona Board of Regents (ABOR) and voting privileges during the second year of the two-year term. Student Regents share the same responsibilities and duties that come from being a Regent on the Arizona Board of Regents. This includes, but may not be limited to, the following: participate in the fiduciary and governing functions of Arizona's three public universities, participate and attend meetings and functions of the Board, represent and provide the student perspective on all matters concerning the Board, and abide by the Loyalty Oath, taken upon entering office, through the entirety of the term on the Board.

#### Qualifications

Each applicant must be a currently enrolled, full-time student at the University of Arizona with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 for undergraduates and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 for graduate students. Applicants must also be residents of the State of Arizona. It is suggested that applicants have a general knowledge of the legislative process in the state of Arizona, a basic understanding of the functions of the Arizona Board of Regents, and a strong desire to represent students statewide.

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### STUDENT REGENT SELECTIONS PROCESS AND TIMELINE

Applications are due Monday, October 22, 2018. After an initial review of applications by the UA Student Regent Search Committee, eligible candidates will be asked to participate in a 30-minute interview to take place between Wednesday, October 31 and Wednesday, November 7 with the Committee. Applicants will then be notified by Friday, November 9 if they are invited to participate in a second round of interviews and reception with the ASUA elected officials and UA members on Tuesday, November 13, 2018. The UA Student Regent Search Committee will then select three finalists and their names will be forwarded to the respective legislative branches of ASUA and GPSC for confirmation and then to the Governor's office. The Governor will then select a nominee and will forward their name to the Arizona State Senate for Senate Confirmation as the new Student Regent. The timeline is subject to change if deemed necessary by the Selection Chair. Applicants and Committee members will be notified of any changes.
